 1. Financial Needs – ensure families are aware of student financial support available to them and continue to support school programs which help needy students.
 2. Physical and Mental Well-Being – support on-going efforts at the school to improve students’ physical and mental well-being and work with students, staff, and parents to identify and support new areas of need.
 3. School/District Funding – advocate for improved funding for the educational needs of LHS students. Support our partners who work on improving funding such as VIS, ISF, and the League of Education Voters.
- Strengthen relationships with our partners. Our efforts will focus on district administration/school board, students, and staff.
 1. District Administration/School Board – communicate directly, where appropriate, to advocate for LH PTSA members and for LHS students.
 2. Students – work jointly where appropriate (Senior Events, ASB, Booster Club, Campus Beautification Club, etc.), meet with student leaders, and encourage students to speak directly to the PTSA Board.
 3. Staff – communicate clearly on programs available to support them, such as Enrichment Grants, and show our gratitude through increased staff appreciation activities.
